

PUTĀRURU NETBALL CENTRE RULES

2024

- Only 3 males can take the court at 1 time. 1 male PER goal circle only, eg. Cannot play GS and GA etc. This applies to Juniors and Seniors.
NO EXCEPTIONS
- SENIOR TEAMS ARE TO UMPIRE THEIR OWN GAMES.
- NO ABUSE OF ANY SORT TOWARDS UMPIRES.
- Only original Scorecards will be accepted.
- No Umpire - No Play, No Duty - No Points, No Payment - No Prize
- Committee members have the right to stand players or teams down if bad language and bad sportsmanship applies.
- NO Alcohol/Drugs/Smoking/Vaping is permitted while inside court area. We do not allow players to play netball while intoxicated.
- NO JEWELLRY / GUM / HATS ARE PERMITTED ON COURT
- NO BIKES / SCOOTERS / ANIMALS inside the court area.
- For SAFETY reasons, could all parents please keep their children out of the car park when (DARK). The Police will be patrolling this area at night.
- **Duty Teams are required to:**
- **SENIORS** - Clean, Sweep and Mop Toilets. Also Sweep and Mop McCurran House if needed. Pick up any Rubbish & Lost property, Empty all BINS.
- Teams on the last round are to bring in all goal pads.
- **NEW DUTY – SCHOOLS – Toilets** – Each school will need to collect Key from Control. Open the Toilets, Monitor Toilets (during the junior rounds only.) Clean toilets at the end, Sweep, Mop if needed, empty Rubbish & restock. Then LOCK and return to control for Senior Duty Team.
- **SCHOOLS - Courts** – Schools rostered on will need to provide parents to put the goal pads and kiwi goals on before the start of the first round, change goals around when needed, and **BRING** all **KIWI GOALS** in after goal changeover. Pick up any surface rubbish in court area, after the last Junior round
- **SCHOOLS – Canteen** – Provide at least 2 Parents to help in the canteen from 3.30pm until the last round of the Juniors.
